I am so excited and thankful to share with you that I have all my support for my trip to India! My tickets are purchased, and we are flying out May 11, only 54 days. I have been filled with joy while watching God faithfully provide above and beyond all I thought I needed for this trip. Thank you for your prayers and support. Over the next two months I will be studying and preparing for the teaching ministry I will have with the women and children. **Please pray** for fruitful times of study, wisdom, proper interpretation, and appropriate application to the lives of the people I will be serving. My passport arrived and I will be sending in my visa application tomorrow; **please pray** the visa application process will be smooth and efficient. **A third request** is for the visa of our team leader Mark Lounsborough; he has written this concerning his visa situation: "The visa application requires me to indicate the name of my employer, which of course is Faith Baptist Bible College. Because it is a religious organization the consulate may require me to sign a statement promising that I will not preach or do any religious activity in India. Of course, I cannot sign such a statement honestly. Therefore the company that will submit my visa has encouraged me to apply for the 30-day, single entry visa instead. It will also require me to state my employer's name, but the consulate may issue this visa since it is for only 30 days. However, there is no guarantee, so we must pray for God's direction." **Finally, please be praying** for the people we will be serving; pray God will prepare their hearts to understand and believe the Word God has entrusted to us to proclaim.
