So far in our study of the Book of Judges, we have covered three judges. First we have Othniel, Caleb's son-in-law, who is presented as a brave and heroic man willing to fight Canaanites in obedience to God's command issued back in the days of Joshua. Next we have Ehud, the south-paw, who is described as a calculating assassin. Then we have Shamgar, the mystery man, who is remembered for his heroic act of slaying 600 Philistines with an ox goad. This evening we will observe that God's people once again "did evil in the sight of the Lord when Ehud was dead." Again, God will allow Israel to be chastened, this time by a Canaanite with a grudge, but He will not allow them to be destroyed. God raises up the fourth judge, Deborah, and her general, Barak. However, the narrative takes a surprising turn.
