Tonight we will be ambitious as we attempt to cover the next three judges. As we work our way through this period of redemptive history, we meet people much like ourselves. On the one hand, the Israelites are secure in the blessings of God, and yet on the other, they still struggle with their sin. The Israelites are continually being pulled away from God toward the worship of Baal and Ashtoreth leading to covenant curses rather than blessings. The judges God sends to rescue them can do nothing to deal with the root of all of Israel's troubles. The parallels are obvious-we too live at a time when we are surrounded by pagan temptations, and we too are constantly being pulled away from Jesus Christ by those who delight in doing what is right in their own eyes.
