As we move into the next cycle of judges, we take up the story of Gideon. This is the most complex cycle we find in this book (100 verses) eclipsing even the account of the more famous Samson (96 verses). The story of Gideon has three distinct parts. Tonight we will look at the first part which tells the story of God sending an oppressor upon Israel along with God's rescue of Israel by raising up Gideon as a warrior who will lead Israel to another stunning victory. Throughout this first part, it is clear that it is God who sovereignly calls Gideon to lead his people, and it is God who is completely responsible for Israel's dramatic victory over their Midianite oppressors.
