Tonight we will look at the remaining obstacle that would hinder all efforts to live upon the things we have been learning. If it is allowed to remain in place, it will make obedience impossible. This obstacle is pragmatism. Pragmatism is a philosophy that values things based upon their apparent effectiveness. "If it works, it must be right." Like the counterfeits of the knowledge of God—knowledge by hearsay, textualism and true truths—pragmatism is offered at a fraction of the cost of a real knowledge of God. Knowing God, seeing Him for who He truly is, requires us to surrender everything to follow Him. It costs us the "right" to rule ourselves that sin has deceitfully offered us.
