**Evening Service ..... 6:00 pm**

Tonight we will explore the answer to another question; maybe you've heard this asked before. "How can a loving God send anyone to hell?" That's a good question, although a bit intimidating, that every Christian needs to wrestle with and understand. In order to understand it we need to turn to Scripture where God reveals Himself and His own character. People mean different things when they say God is "loving." Some mean that God is a completely tolerant God, that He tolerates anything and everything. Others mean that God is completely, and in every way, merciful and shows mercy to everyone—or at least He should, they would argue. When we turn to Scripture we see God is not "loving" in the sense that we are loving but that God is actually the definition of love. He is love. We must look at God in His character and all of His attributes to understand what it means for God to be love.
