Keep the Faith

In the young couples' Bible class, the pastor talked about the story of Abraham and Sarah. Although well into old age before their son was born, they had faith in God's promise that they would have a child. The pastor asked the class, "What lesson can we take away from this story?" A young mother of three who was having financial difficulties blurted out, "They were smart and waited until they could afford a baby!"

*Why was Christ "despised and rejected of men?"
...because He demanded repentance. "Repent ye, and believe the gospel" (Mk 1:15), was His demanding call. That order is unchanging, for it is impossible to believe the Gospel till the heart be contrite. Repentance is taking sides with God against ourselves. It is the unsparing judgment of ourselves because of our high-handed rebellion. It is a ceasing to love and tolerate sin, and to excuse ourselves for committing it...
Christ taught, "Except he repent, ye shall all like wise perish" (Lk 13:3), for He would not condone evil. He came to save His people from their sins, and not in them.*
