The crucifixion of Christ, the scene ~

The outskirts of Jerusalem. The city witnessed the magnificence of Solomon's reign, and here the temple stood. The Lord Jesus had taught and wrought miracles, and into this city He had ridden a few days earlier seated upon an ass as the multitudes cried, "Hosanna to the son of David: blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest" (Mt 21:9)--so fickle is human nature. Israel had rejected their King and therefore He was conducted beyond the bounds of the city, so that He "suffered without the gate" (Heb. 13:12). The actual place was Golgotha, "the place of a skull." The contour of the ground resembled a death's head. Luke gives the Gentile name "Calvary" for the guilt of that death rested on both lew and Gentile.
