*The Redemption of Christ ~
 "For he [God] hath made him [Christ] to be sin for us, who knew no sin;
 that we might be [not put into a capacity of acquiring a righteousness of our own,
 but] made the righteousness of God in him" (2 Co 5:21).
 Here is the double imputation of our sins to Christ and of His righteousness to us.
 We are not said to be made righteous, but "righteousness" itself;
 and not righteousness only, but "the righteousness of God" the utmost
 that language can reach.
