Throughout time, man has made numerous attempts to deal with the issue of meaning in a systematic, organized fashion, resulting with a philosophy of history. A philosophy of history is commonly defined as "a systematic interpretation of universal history in accordance with a principle by which historical events and successions are unified and directed toward ultimate meaning." Now that's a mouth full, but it is important to understand these things. For the past three to four hundred years, Bible-believing Christians have developed two distinct approaches to expositing the Bible's philosophy of history with each approach producing a system of theology. These two systems are known as Covenant Theology and Dispensationalism. This afternoon we will begin our examination of these systems.
