Excerpt from "Guide to Ecclesiastical Birdwatching", **by LeRoy Koopman** Cold-blooded Seat Shifter

In every flock there is always present at least one Cold-blooded Seat Shifter. The female of this not uncommon species has an inbred suspicion of walls with openings and a dread fear of all moving air, real and imagined.

Even in summer, this flighty bird arrives full-feathered and wearing long-sleeved plumage. She alights fitfully, continually searching for a perch in the church which is distant from all open doors and windows, away from all fans and air conditioners, free of all drafts and cross-currents. No matter where she settles, she shivers.

The most distinctive characteristics of this unusual creature are her huddled posture and her ceaseless efforts to pull her shoulder feathers higher than her neck. Also typical of this species are her cold claws, goose pimples and quivering
