Dan & Karis Mapes: Dan was in Ghana for 3 weeks this past summer & was able to resolve the issue with purchasing the truck, and to help out with VBS in 3 areas, are still waiting on the Lord to resolve issues regarding their return as a family, pray for wisdom; Mapes are involved in the work at Temple Baptist in Omaha; The Ministry in Ghana: 2 financial needs have been met: Isaac, a church member from Jinjini, born with a leg deformity, needed a prosthetic, it was provided by Emmanuel Baptist Church of Berekum, and a motor bike has been provided to enable Pastor Steven to get around town easier for visitation; Cathy, the only nurse at the clinic in Ghana, has had to temporarily close the clinic for a few months while she returns to the States for some R&R and medical tmt, pray that the Lord will raise up some nurses to join her in this ministry; a couple has stepped in to be caretakers for the guest house; Ghana web site has much information and pictures of other happenings: <http://bmmghana.com/>
