Scott & Susan Sloan: after returning from our Missions Conference, Scott baptized 7, the ministry there remains stable, & they've seen a little growth in numbers; continue to pray for strong leadership and people in the church to be burdened for the lost in the community, they have a burden for the lost in other parts of the world, but need that passion for folks in the community; about 10 people attend who are not saved, they enjoy Bible exposition but have not made a decision for Christ; several men at the prison have been saved; Susan's dad battles with multiple seizures each week, his greatest need is salvation, Scott's mom still fights with her illness
