Have you heard of using the Romans Road to lead a person to Christ? When Missionary Glen Galbraith (Great Britian) was with us a few years ago, he gave us what he called the 'Romans Road to Prayer'. Here is that Romans Road to Prayer:

- Rom. 1:9 - have a never-ending, constant attitude of prayer
- Rom. 10:1 - for "Kalispell" to be saved
- Rom. 15:30 - 'strive together' for missionaries in prayer; specifics are in verses 31-33: safety, service and sweet fellowship
