This week's passage is 1 Samuel 2:2.

Aaron & Jenny Peterson, to Germany: Aaron grew up on the mission field of Germany. He accepted Christ at age 7 and surrendered to full time Christian service when he was in 8th grade. Aaron went to Bible College in 2001 where he and Jenny met. After graduating in 2005 and getting married the same year, Aaron spent the next four years helping his wife finish college in 2009. Jenny grew up in Montana, accepted Christ at age 7 and immediately became very active in serving the Lord. At age 10 Jenny's parents divorced which promoted many of the bad decisions that she made for the next several years. God used a car wreck to get her attention when she was a freshman in high school. After that Jenny began to slowly come back to the Lord. At age 20 Jenny fully gave her life to the Lord and went to Michigan to help an Arabic missionary where she learned that there is such a thing as Bible College. After less than a year in Michigan, Jenny went to Bible College where she met her husband Aaron. Jenny and Aaron started full time deputation in June of 2010 and have since been joined by their sons Nathan (1/29/2010) and William (4/1/2012).
